- 1. Describe the host's educational oversight to ensure students with disabilities are educated in the least restrictive environment while in the 1306 facility? (If not a host, answer as if you were.)

 At this time we have no facility for students that fits this description. When a student enters our School District from 1306 homes, we evaluate the current placement, and if the student is being educated within the Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 (CIU20) programs, we continue the placement. If the student is not appropriately placed, we would convene the IEP team to explore possible placements to meet the academic and/or behavioral needs of the student while considering supplementary aides and services within the least restrictive environment in order for the student to demonstrate meaningful academic and/or behavioral gains. Furthermore, the School District would ensure that a certified special education teacher is providing services and that the student is receiving a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE).
- 2. Describe the district's procedures for communicating with 1306 facilities and how the district ensures a successful transition back to school?
 - Given a placement, the school district has a procedure in which the student's counselor facilitates communication between the school, facility, and families to plan for a transition back to school. This includes maintaining ongoing communication about the student's status, participating in meetings including discharge, and facilitating communication among the family and school team in regard to the transition back to school including consideration of supports and accommodations in the school setting to create a supportive return to school.

1. Describe the system of oversight the District would implement to ensure that all incarcerated students who may be eligible for special education are located, identified, evaluated and when deemed eligible, are offered a free appropriate public education (FAPE).

Incarcerated students in the Northampton County Juvenile Justice Center are educated while they are in the detention or treatment facility. Adult students incarcerated in the Northampton County Correctional Facility under the age of 21, who have not graduated, are provided an education. Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 provides the teaching and staff for these locations. We send the students' special education records to the facility upon request and work to ensure when students are released that a meeting is held and a seamless transition is made back to the appropriate school setting.



Least Restrictive Environment

- 1. Review the district's data for Least Restrictive Environment. Highlight areas of improvement.
 - The Nazareth Area School District ensures that, to the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities are educated with their non-disabled peers. Upon review of the School District's five-year longitudinal data, the data indicates an increase in students with disabilities participating in the regular education setting for more than 80% of the day. This data supports that the IEP team is considering the Least Restrictive Environment as well as Supplementary Aides and Services in order to meet the student's academic and/or behavioral needs. Furthermore, the data also indicates a decrease in students in private facilities. In an effort to increase the number of students within the LRE, the district plans to continue to monitor the level of support and/or opportunities for students to be included with their non-disabled peers to the maximum extent possible. Furthermore, the district will provide staff with additional professional development opportunities to meet the complex academic and behavioral needs for an increasingly diverse population.
- 2. What universal practices does the district utilize to address the academic and social/emotional needs of all students in need of accommodations to their learning environments?
 - The district utilizes the RTII/MTSS model to support students in the areas of reading and mathematics. School-wide positive behavior support plans are utilized in grades K-8. In grades 7-12, additional assistance is offered via academic support/study skills courses. Based on need as determined by the IEP team, some students may qualify to participate in social skills groups. In addition, each building conducts regular Child Study Team meetings to address individual students' concerns, which can be referred by any building staff member.
- 3. Describe the academic programming and training efforts the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in the general education curriculum. Professional development opportunities are developed yearly based on a combination of identified needs as well as feedback from personnel on their professional development needs. The NASD utilizes a professional development model that allows for differentiated opportunities based on personnel needs and preferences.
- 4. Describe the supplementary aids and services the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in extracurricular activities.
 - All students enrolled in the district are strongly encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities. This topic is discussed at IEP meetings so families have the information necessary to support their child in these activities. Supplementary aids and services necessary for students to participate in extra-curricular activities are provided based on an individual student's needs as determined by the IEP team. Information and consultation are provided to coaches and activity/club sponsors as needed. Additionally, paraprofessional support and, in some cases, teachers attend the after-school activities to help support the students who need that level of additional support in order to participate, as determined by the IEP team.
- 5. Describe the District procedures, which ensure that, to the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities placed in private institutions are educated with non-disabled children and have the opportunity to participate in district lead extracurricular activities?
 - Given the placement of a student in a private institution, the student's IEP team makes the decision about the student's educational placement including the time spent with nondisabled peers. If interested, students placed in private institutions may participate in extracurricular activities. For these students, the team would also consider specialized needs associated with transportation, arrival and departure times given varying schedules, etc., and would accommodate those needs.

6. Discuss the district's need to build capacity and expand programs and services in an effort to provide a continuum of services. (Consider the out of district placement chart)

The district routinely reviews the support and services provided to students, their location, and their provider. Most recently the district determined that additional emotional and behavioral supports need to be provided within the district. Effective the 2022/2023 school, the district has emotional support programs in all 6 buildings. In addition, to provide students with sensory support, the district created a sensory classroom in the elementary schools. The sensory room uses a multi-disciplinary and multi-tiered approach to provide students with a safe and therapeutic space to address sensory processing needs by providing opportunities for self-regulation, facilitating prevention and de-escalation strategies, and promoting positive social-emotional skills. Also during the 2022/2023 school year, the district purchased a Practical Assessment Exploration System (PAES) Lab to be utilized for students of transition age. PAES operates as a simulated work environment. Students become employees, and teachers become supervisors. Strict procedures are followed so the students get the feel of real work, and at the same time, they learn and explore new career vocational areas. The PAES lab assesses a student's competitive work potential and interest level, while simultaneously exploring various jobs, using real tools, and developing proper work behaviors. Furthermore, during the 2023/2024 school year, a Simulated Apartment was created at Nazareth High School. The Simulated Apartment is a unique learning space designed to equip students with special needs with the skills they need for successful post-secondary education and independent living. The Simulated Apartment initiative aligns perfectly with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) of 2015, which emphasizes the importance of ensuring equal opportunity, full participation, independent living, and economic self-sufficiency for individuals with disabilities. The Simulated Apartment provides a realistic and engaging environment where students can gain practical experience in essential daily living skills. Through evidence-based practices, hands-on activities, and real-world applications. The skills honed in the Simulated Apartment will seamlessly transition to post-secondary and the broader community, fostering deeper engagement and expanding opportunities for students with special needs. This holistic approach empowers them to build confidence, independence, and selfsufficiency, preparing them for a fulfilling future beyond the classroom

1. How does the district support the emotional, social needs of students with disabilities?

The emotional and social needs of students with disabilities are addressed based on individual student needs. Students can be provided informal behavioral supports or formal functional behavioral assessments and positive behavior support plans. Additionally, they can be provided group or individual social skill instruction or access to individual or small group social/emotional groups. We provide emotional support programming via emotional support classrooms in all 6 of our buildings. In addition, we contract with Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 (CIU20) for therapeutic emotional support programming, which includes a full-time behavioral health provider at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. Students eligible for special education are also able to access our school-based outpatient therapy known as Your Emotional Strength Supported (YESS!) program with St. Luke Health Network, which the district contracts with for services for ALL students.

2. Describe training provided to staff in the use of positive behavior supports, de-escalation techniques and responses to behavior that may require immediate intervention.

Nazareth Area SD has a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) on staff, who is a trainer in Therapeutic Aggression Control Techniques (TACT-2). Furthermore, effective the 20232024 school year, the district contracted for 2 Licensed Behavior Specialist Consultants (LBSCs) and 3 Registered Behavior Technicians (RBT) to provide behavioral support as a Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 level of support. Yearly and ongoing training is provided to district personnel at each building in the event that a student requires staff/adults to regulate his/her behavior in a more structured way. Necessary staff receive annual training as per the TACT-2 guidelines. Teams from every building are trained on a regular basis and in accordance with training requirements.

3. Describe the district positive school wide support programs.

The Nazareth Area SD School Board directs that the district's behavior support programs shall be based on positive rather than negative behavior techniques to ensure that students are free from demeaning treatment and unreasonable use of restraints or other aversive techniques. The use of restraints shall be considered a measure of last resort and shall only be used after other less restrictive measures, including de-escalation techniques. Behavior support programs and plans shall be based on a functional behavior assessment and shall include a variety of research-based techniques to develop and maintain skills that will enhance students' opportunities for learning and self-fulfillment. Each school building has staff who support the collection of data associated with behavior and the development of individualized plans to support students who need additional, more intensive support. At the elementary level, teams use Child Study Team (CST) meetings as well as the instructional support team process to consider data and provide academic and behavioral interventions. Additionally, Core Essentials is built into the PBIS framework. They also use morning meetings and Second Step in various elementary buildings at various grade levels. Additionally, the district has Student Assistant Program (SAP) teams at each building. Furthermore, effective the 2022/2023 school year, special education staff (K-8) will be implementing the Zones of Regulation model into their classrooms. At the middle school level, teams use student CST, SAP, as well as the instructional support team process to consider data and provide academic and behavioral

interventions. At the high school level, teams use CST meetings and the SAP process to consider data and provide academic and behavioral interventions.

4. Describe the district school-based behavior health services.

The Nazareth Area School District partners with St. Luke's University Health Network to provide schoolbased behavioral health services. This service is available in each of the District's schools. St. Luke's University Health Network offers the Your Emotional Strength Supported (YESS!) school-based therapy program in the school districts throughout St. Luke's coverage area. This program provides integrated mental health treatment for children, adolescents, and teens in the designated schools. The YESS! Program helps students overcome emotional, behavioral or social problems that interfere with success at school and at home. As members of the school-based team, St. Luke's therapists can serve students in a familiar setting, offering minimal interruption to their school day. Services may include: Overcoming behavioral, emotional, or social problems that interfere with success at school and at home Reducing disruptive behavior Improving self-monitoring skills Psychiatric assessment Psychiatric medication management Tele-psychiatry visits for students and family Common issues may include: Aggression Anxiety Depression Isolation Poor social skills Stress Trauma Truancy St. Luke's therapists work with the students and collaborate with school staff and parents to help reduce disruptive behavior and improve self-monitoring skills. St. Luke's school-based therapists are master's level credentialed to provide services based on their degree in social work, counseling or psychology. Referrals Students, teachers, counselors, principals, providers, or parents may make referrals In addition to the support within the district, CIU20 continues to offer two behavioral health centers that provide medical and therapeutic services to students with mental health needs. These health centers have evening appointments to provide flexible accessibility for students and parents. The two locations are convenient for our student population to access and help students to remain in the least restrictive setting. All school counselors are aware of this support and are able to refer students to this service as needed. In addition, our Student Assistance Program (SAP) provides the opportunity for students to receive weekly counseling during the school day through an outside agency.

5. Describe the district restraint procedure.

Restraint should only be used as a last resort and given immediate danger to the student or others. Per policy #113.2, the use of restraints shall not be included in the IEP for the convenience of staff, as a substitute for an educational program, or employed as punishment. Restraints may be included in an IEP with parental consent only if: 1. The restraint is used with specific component elements of a Positive Behavior Support Plan. 2. The restraint is used in conjunction with teaching socially appropriate alternative skills or behaviors. 3. Staff are authorized to use the restraint and have received appropriate training. 4. The Positive Behavior Support Plan includes efforts to eliminate the use of restraints. Board Policy #113.2 indicates the Superintendent or designee will provide regular training, and retraining as needed, of staff in the use of specific procedures, methods, and techniques, including de-escalation techniques, emergency responses, restraints, and seclusions, that will be used to implement positive behavior supports or interventions in accordance with students' IEPs, Positive Behavior Support Plans, and Board policy. NASD has a professional staff member certified as a trainer in Therapeutic Aggression Control Techniques (TACT-2). The staff member provides training to designated administrators, faculty, and support staff in each building to maintain a safe learning environment for all. Given a restraint, which is only used as a last resort when the student is an immediate danger to him/herself or others, parents are contacted to report the restraint, and the restraint is reported to the special education office. The staff involved in the restraint complete an incident report and a restraint report documenting the specific behaviors leading to the restraint, the type of restraint, length of restraint, and training of those who completed the restraint. Following the restraint, a meeting is held to review the student's needs and to consider 1. whether an FBA is necessary if not already in place, 2. if an FBA/PBSP exists, whether it needs revised, and 3. what

additional changes should be made to prevent restraint in the future. It is also possible to waive the meeting if parents agree and sign a waiver. This is used sparingly and typically if the team has met very recently

needed to provide the programming.

Please address any areas of concern with students who are placed on Instruction Conducted in the Home or who are at a substantial risk of waiting more than 30 days for an appropriate educational placement. Based on the data, the Nazareth Area SD only has 1 student who is receiving Instruction Conducted in the Home, and that is due to the student's significant medical needs. The district is able to provide instruction and related services to the student while meeting their IEP needs. Therefore, as a district, we do not have any concerns for students who are placed on Instruction Conducted in the Home as this is an IEP team decision, and we follow the requirements set forth in IDEA and Pennsylvania Chapter 14 for this process and/or consideration. At this time, Nazareth Area School District is able to ensure a free appropriate education (FAPE) to all students in every disability category. The LEA takes steps to work closely with families, agencies, and Colonial Intermediate Unit 20 (CIU20) to provide an appropriate program. If there is no suitable plan that can safely maintain and educate the student, we register the student with the interagency process through the state. When warranted we meet with our local county team (CASSP) to help a student in need of both academic and behavioral support, both in school and at home. In this way every agency working with the student is able to meet with the family and student to help find a way to best support them. Given a situation in which a student is at risk of waiting more than 30 days for an appropriate educational placement, the district would collaborate with the local intermediate unit, other local school districts, outside educational program providers, and/or local agencies, etc. to identify the appropriate placement and/or acquire the resources
