On June 22, 2016 the United States Department of Agriculture in conjunction with the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act began innovating share table/carts as an innovative strategy to encourage the consumption of nutritious foods as well as reduce food waste in the National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs. The Pennsylvania Department of Education reissued this innovative strategy as an abundance of packaged fruits and vegetables were being wasted in the National School Breakfast and Lunch programs.
